Nomad Mk3 Rohloff AB 700c Special

This is a very specific machine. It uses a Mercury 853 V brake fork and the light 700c wheels from the Mercury build. It also includes the Airy titanium rear carrier. The resulting machine is almost as light as a 700c Mercury with identical 853 fork, wheels, tyres and carrier but, thanks to the Nomad's longer chainstays, it will carry up to 24kg of luggage, when required, on the rear carrier alone. (Which is more than enough for lightweight cycle camping) This has 3 benefits - (1) The 853 fork provides unsurpassed comfort. (2) Carrying the load entirely on the rear of the bike means that the effects of strong headwinds are reduced. (3) The Nomad Mk3 AB 700c Special actually weighs less than a Mercury 700c set up to carry the same payload. (To carry 24kg a Mercury would need to be equipped with the Thorn Standard fork and lo-loaders.) **But note:** when carrying very light loads, a Mercury with identical 853 fork, wheels, tyres and Airy carrier would feel more lively.

With the appropriate tyres, the AB 700c Special is also extremely capable on gravel roads. Provided it's ridden with due care, We're sure that the younger generation of "hammock and tarp" adventurers would find this the ideal machine. If you worry (needlessly in our experience) what you would do if you encountered problems with your hub, it will give you confidence to know that the Mk3 is capable of being fitted with derailleur gears. The Mk3 is also equipped with a gate to allow you to fit belt drive, if you must have it, once you've determined what spread of gears you need.

The Nomad Mk3 AB 700c Special is equipped with a rear disc brake and a V front brake.

Build 7a straight bars

Wheels...Deore Black front hub. DT Swiss TK 540 32h 700c rim. Or Son 28 dynohub. Black Rohloff disc rear hub. DT Swiss TK 540 32h 700c disc rim. Hope 160mm rotor for Rohloff.

Tyres...Schwalbe Marathon Supreme 40c tyres + tubes and tapes or upgrade to tubeless— Schwalbe Marathon Supreme 40c, Schwalbe HS472 G-One speed 40c, Schwalbe HS 473 G-One Allround 40c or Schwalbe HS473 G-One bite 40c. All tubeless options now use ultra lightweight tubes with sealant. For heavier duty use choose Schwalbe Marathon Almotion 40c. For heavier duty use choose Schwalbe Marathon Almotion 40c.

Brakes F...Shimano XT V brake. R...TRP Spyke cable operated disc brake with TRP rotor. Levers...Shimano XT

Bars...Thorn FFT bars 620mm (or cut to suit). Grips...Ergon GP5L. Stem...Kalloy AS-021 UNO (or similar oversize stem) to suit customer's set up dimensions. Rohloff gear shifter.

Gearing...Thorn black 104 BCD 170mm (or length to suit customer's dimensions) Thorn 40t single 104 BCD chainring (or customer's choice) Rohloff 17t splined sprocket. (or customer's choice). KMC Rohloff-specific chain.

Accessories...3 x Profile bottle cages, SKS black mudguards, Airy titanium carrier. (Option to fit Tubus Vega instead. Option also for the neat installation of the superb Moon Pulsar rear LED light)

Saddle...Thorn Velo saddle, men's or women's (as appropriate) or option to have no saddle or upgrade to any other saddle stocked by SJS Cycles.

If you are certain that you want to have dropped bars, which necessitate a fairly sporty riding position, for this style of cycling, we can oblige.

Build 7b drop bars

The wheels, Tyres, Accessories and Saddle options are the same as with the straight bar build above - only the brakes and bars are different.

Brakes...F&R TRP Spyke cable operated disc brakes with Hope Rohloff rotor. Levers...Tektro drop bar levers for V brakes.

Bars...Van Nicholas 44cm dropped bars with black cork tape. Van Nicholas stem. Rohloff gear shifter.
